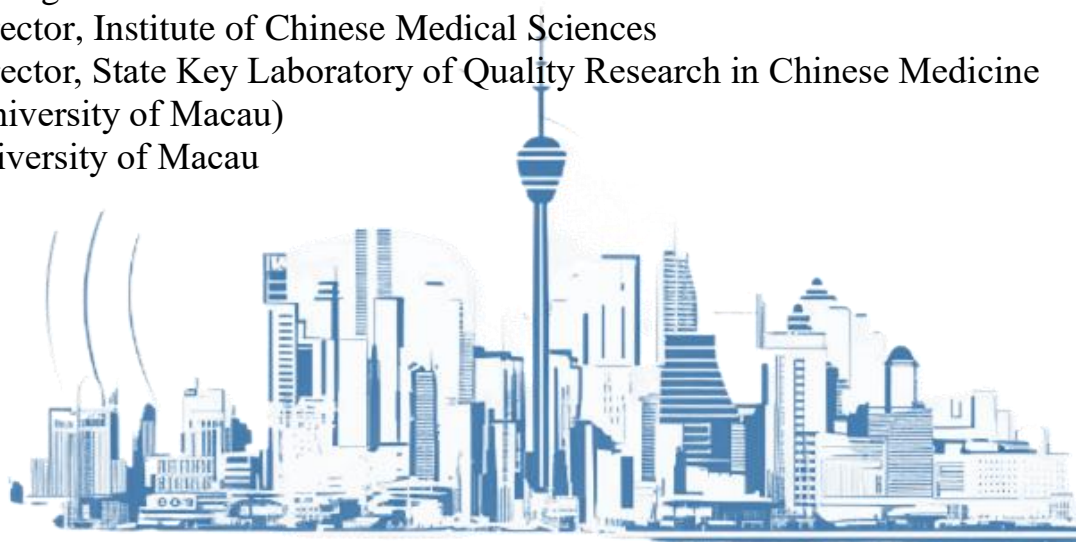

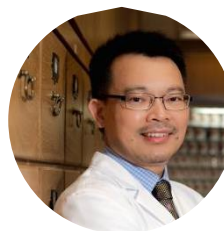

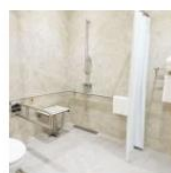

How to get to UM:

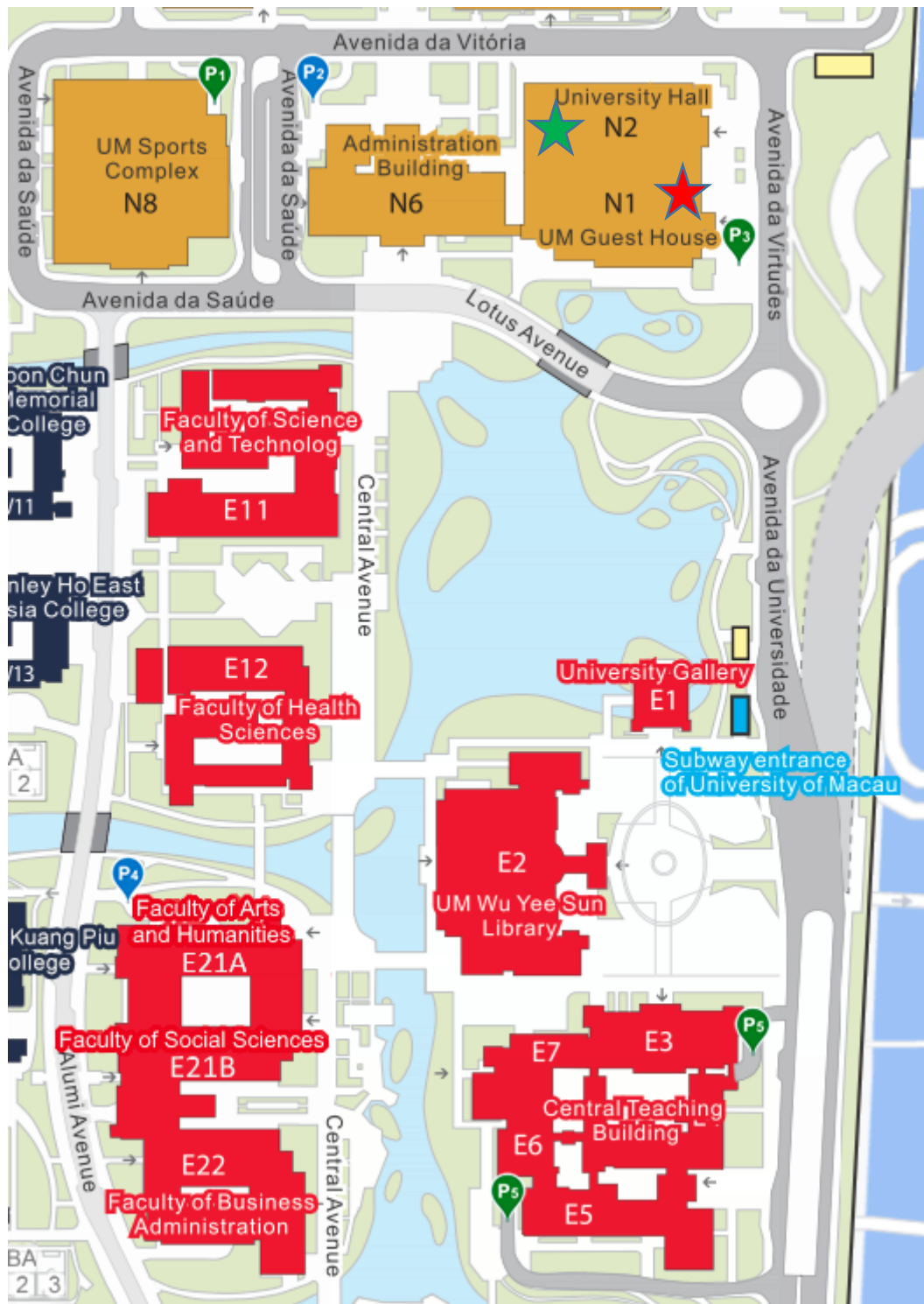
You may take taxi or public bus to the N1-UM Guest House and N2-University Hall (Bus Stop: T554 UM / University Hall (澳大/大學會堂)).
